Smarter Energy, Cleaner Future

We have switched almost all lighting to energy-saving LEDs, added timer and expanded solar pathway lights. Next up: extending solar hot water systems to half of our villas by 2026.

Every Drop Counts

Our water conservation journey continues: Smart water-saving fixtures in all villas. Dualflush systems and guest awareness campaigns reduced usage by 11% this year

-Goal: Keep consumption below 250L per guest per day by 2026.

Waste Not, Want Not

We have introduced composting for organic waste and improved waste segregation to over 70% accuracy. All departments now recycle and reuse wherever possible. Even our gardens thrive with compost made right here on the island

Protecting Our Oceans

Together with the Marine Ecology Research Centre (MERC) we are restoring coral reefs and increasing marine awareness. With our many Coral replanting programmes, giant clam rehabilitation programmes, daily debris clean-ups and school programmes are our continuous effort in protecting our beloved ocean.

Caring for Our Community

Sustainability means giving back, too. Over 200 students joined our Marine Awareness Month, 100 island families received reusable bags and bottles, and 98% of our team members are proudly from Sabah.
